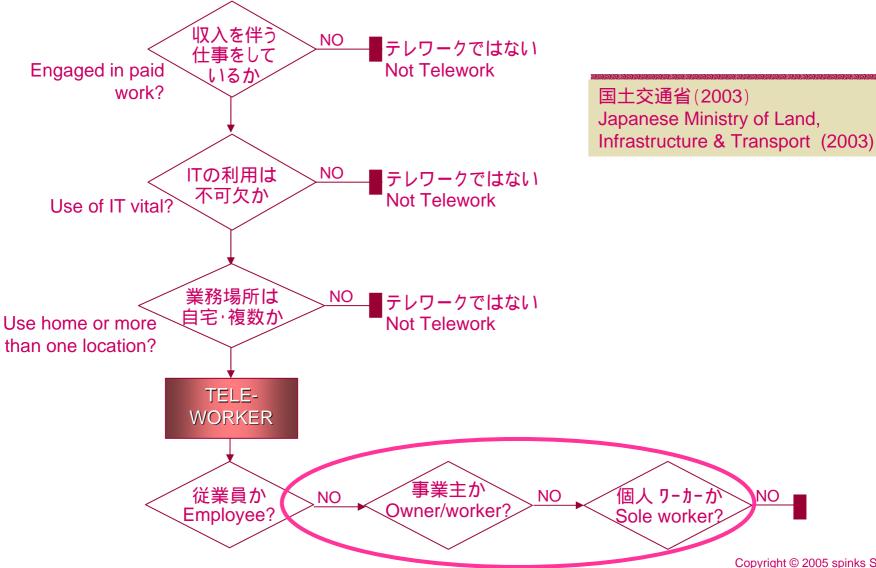

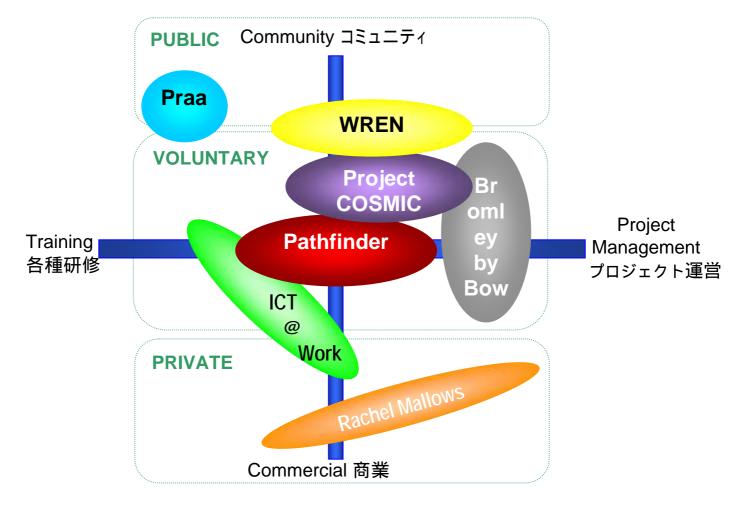

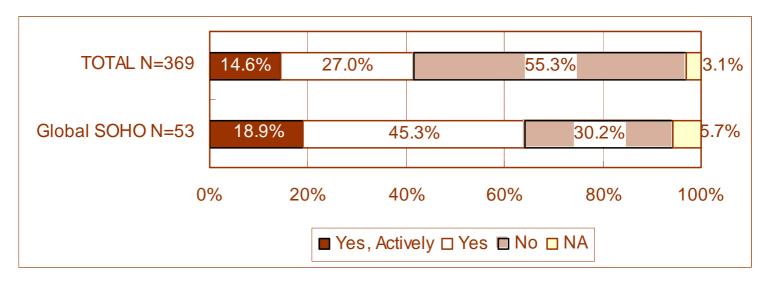

活動別地域活動・NPO参加の度合い

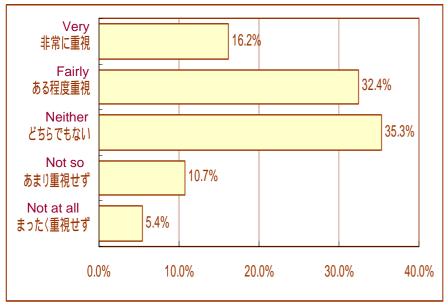




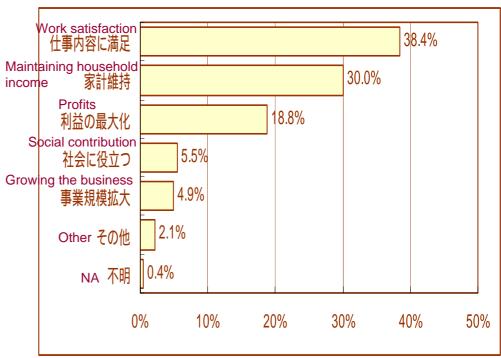

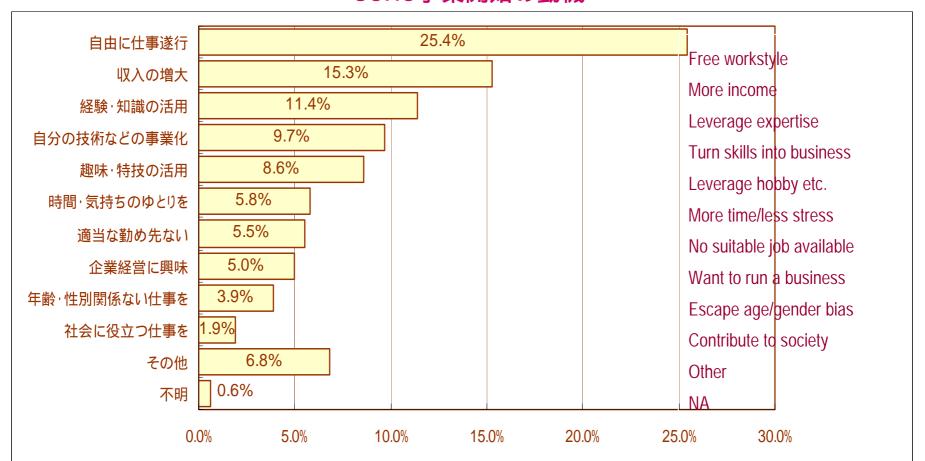
